Due to the COVID-19 crisis, the Tour is **going virtual** for the 2020-21 school year with a completely revised program featuring the biggest names from the **NBA, NFL, Action Sports, the Olympics, Music, Streaming, Gaming and Entertainment** delivering messages of hope and inspiration to students.



100% **free** to schools and operates seamlessly whether the students are in a **classroom setting** or participating in **distance learning**.



The No Place for Hate virtual assembly is a combination of **live** and **pre-recorded messages** with an emcee that delivers essential information in a **fun, positive and interactive fashion**.



Well-known **celebrities** will speak **directly to the students** about their own experiences with bullying while offering advice about overcoming obstacles, **being an ally**, inclusion, kindness, surrounding yourself with positive influences, problem solving, and other important subjects that resonate with kids during a time when so many people are suffering.



Students **can win prizes**, including the new **Xbox Series X**, and participate in contests to create additional **engagement**.

WHAT WE PROVIDE



A high-end technical platform to allow students and administrators to join the Event virtually whether in a classroom setting or through remote learning.



A unique URL link for each school to join the virtual program.



A professional emcee / host to run the show, get the students involved, and deliver the bullying prevention message points.



8 – 9 pre-produced personal stories from well-known celebrities, athletes, musicians, influencers, etc.



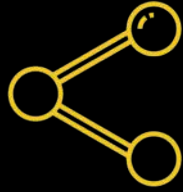
An ASA administrative member to moderate the technical platform and be available during Event.

Schedule a date for entire student body to attend the program through one mandatory **30 – 35 minute** virtual assembly period.



Distribution of a URL link to each teacher if classes are in-person and / or to each student that is doing remote learning.



Promotion of the Event to get the students excited about the program, including distribution of a promotional flyer about the program (provided by ASA).

Participating schools don't need to do any work beyond scheduling the program and informing the students.
